

How the Summer Programs work

Over the summer, OLLB Competitive teams compete in two programs. One is the City League that all of our teams from Minor to Senior play in (see info below). In all of our divisions, with the exception of Senior, we have two teams. One is named the "Tournament" or "A" Team and the other is named the "City League or "B" Team. Mid July, the Tournament Teams leave the City League to play in the District 6 Little League Tournaments championships and the right to represent the District at the Provincial Tournaments that are played at different locations around Ontario. If any of our teams win a Provincial championship*, they go on to a Canadian championship and the winner of that goes to the Little League World Series played in various locations around the U.S. They return to the City League when they have gone as far as they can (or win the World Series!) They resume the City League season, playing until the end of August.

*Minor teams play to the Provincial level only.

Big League also plays in the City League. However, they do not compete for a District championship. Rather a District all-star team is chosen from all of the District Big League teams and that team represents District 6 at the Provincials Tournament and beyond. They also return to the City League when they have gone as far as they can.

City League

District 2 maintains the City League schedule and standings. For the Minor to Junior divisions, they refer to the teams that will be competing in the Districts as 'Canadian' and the teams that plays the full summer in City League as 'National'. The Senior division only has teams that will be competing in the Districts and then returning to the City League.
